

# New gas and highways investments for Gaol Road and Sandon Road

**A major joint West Midlands Gas Alliance and Staffordshire Highways investment in Gaol Road, Sandon Road and Browning Street in Stafford gets under way at the end of June.**

**This will deliver new gas mains and highway improvements for the local community.**

Over the decades the old iron gas main has reached the end of its useful life. Now it really needs replacing with a modern plastic system. This work is vital to protect gas supplies to homes and businesses and to protect public safety.

And while this work is being done Staffordshire Highways is taking advantage of the opportunity to resurface the roadway, improve kerbs, drainage and footpaths along Sandon Road and Browning Street.

The joint programme aims to maximise the benefits while minimising the inconvenience to the local community and businesses.

## What's happening and when

### Phase One: ■

The work will kick off with the closure of Gaol Road to allow the

replacement of the gas main in what is a very tight street scene.

This phase of the programme should last approximately 4 weeks. There will be no through traffic but access to shops, businesses and properties will be protected.

Through traffic will be diverted via the A34 Greyfriars.

### Phase Two: ■

Starts at the back end of July and will see gas mains replaced and the upgrade of the highway along Sandon Road and Browning Street.

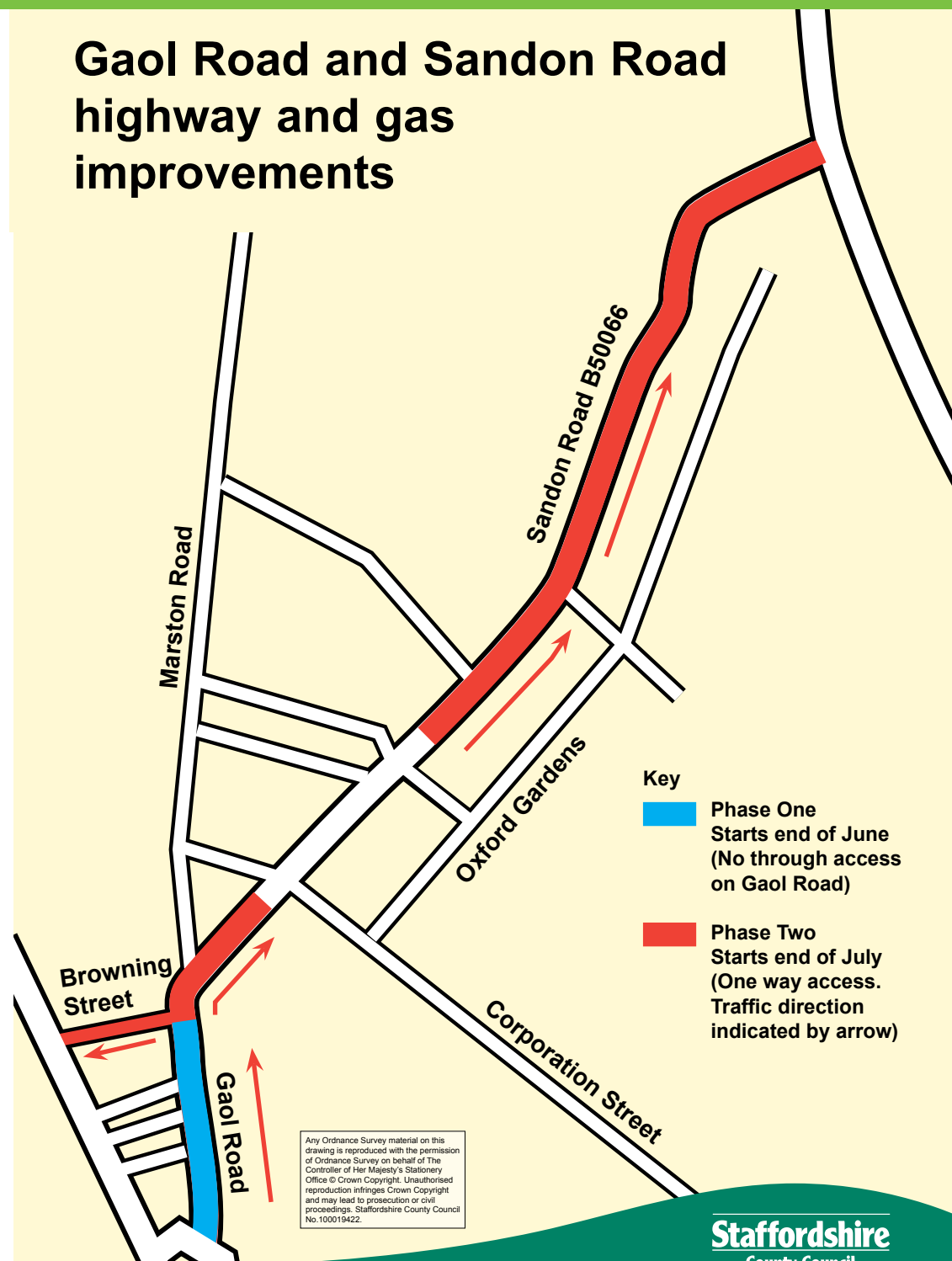
Traffic will flow again but only one way north bound up Gaol Road and Sandon Road, and one way out along Browning Street to the A34 Greyfriars.

South bound traffic will continue to be diverted via the A34 Stone Road.

This work is vital for the future of your community. West Midlands Gas Alliance and Staffordshire Highways are working together to make the operation as smooth and efficient as possible.
