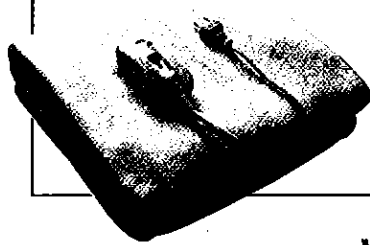


HOW SAFE IS YOUR ELECTRIC BLANKET?

Get your electric blanket tested
FREE OF CHARGE

While you wait at the following Test Venue:

Cannock Community Fire Station- Old Hednesford Road
9th September
10:00-12:30 & 14:00- 16:00

If you are unable to attend the Test Days you may drop your blanket off for testing at:

Rugeley Fire Station

Drop off on 6th & 8th September only, between 09:00 and 11:00 hours
Collect on 13th & 15th September only, between 09:00 and 11:00 hours

Hednesford/Heath Hayes Library

Drop off on 8th September only, between 09:00 and 17:00 hours
Collect on 10th September only, between 09:30 and 13:00 hours

Cannock Community Fire Station

Drop off on 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th September only, between 10:00 and 16:00 hours
Collect on 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th September only, between 10:00 and 16:00 hours

Rugeley Library

Drop off on 7th September only, between 09:00 and 13:00 hours
OR

Drop off on 8th September only, between 09:00 and 18:00 hours
Collect on 10th September only, between 09:00 and 16:00 hours

If you have any queries regarding the Electric Blanket Testing,

The test venues will not be open to the public until the time stated above.

Should your blanket fail the test we will be unable to return it to you. Everyone over the age of 60 will be offered a standard single or double under blanket as a replacement
