Course Summary

This course aims to build on skills developed on the BSL Level 1 course. The course will provide a greater understanding of the different linguistic components of BSL, including: Fingerspelling, role shift, classifiers, idioms and non-manual features. It will develop the student's ability to communicate with deaf people about a range of real life, routine and daily experiences. On completion, students will be more aware of the appropriate range of conversational strategies and elements of accurate production and reception. A greater awareness of the Deaf community and culture will also be gained.
