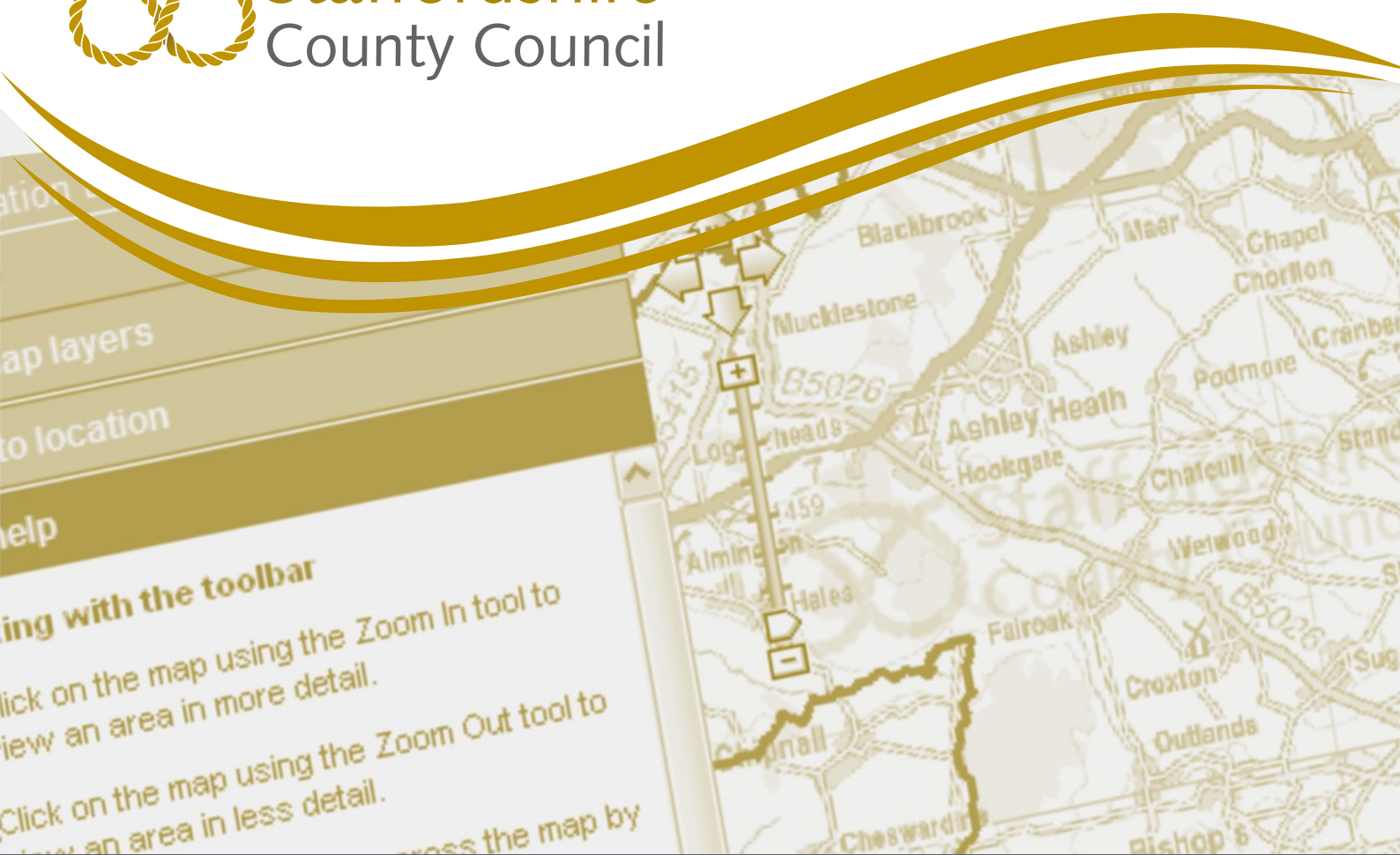

## Internet System Information on Map Layers

## Introduction (Document Purpose)

This document is intended to provide assistance to users of the Staffordshire County Council LocalView internet system who would like to clarify the information displayed via the map layers available under the 'On The Map' tab.

For each map layer the document provides:

1. A brief statement to clarify the content of the map layer and, where appropriate, to highlight specific issues with the information.
2. Any restrictions in the map scales at which the map layer can be displayed. It should be noted that the LocalView internet system does not currently report specific display scales to users. Hence this information is supplied as general guidance only. The most common reasons for restrictions will be:
  - a. The map layer contains a large amount of information, which would result in a very slowed display update for a large area of map.
  - b. The map layer is insufficiently accurate for appropriate display when the map is 'zoomed in' to a high level of detail.
3. One or more contact email addresses that can be used if further information is required about the map layer. LocalView users may also wish to use these contacts to report any errors found in the map information. Emails will be forwarded to the County Council officer responsible for the map layer. Web addresses which contain further information are also provided where appropriate. In order to assist in using this document alongside the LocalView internet system, the information on map layers is provided in the same order as they appear in the system itself.

### Democratic Boundaries

#### **County, District, Parish and Ward**

**Statement:** Boundaries for the administrative area type selected. These map layers are extracted from Ordnance Survey 'Boundary-Line' mapping information.

## Community

### **Families First Local Support Teams**

**Statement:** The Families First Service is a new way of working that brings together the full range of County Council professionals that help children, young people or their families. The service covers the whole of Staffordshire but is delivered through 20 geographical patches spread across Staffordshire's eight districts. Local Support Teams consist of Children's Service professionals who work together across a patch to identify and address family needs early.

## Heat Loss (South Staffordshire)

**Statement:** South Staffordshire Council have taken a unique approach into tackling climate change, energy efficiency and fuel poverty by highlighting how much heat loss is generated by each building in the district.

By taking a thermal image of every building on a cold clear night in winter, we can see how much heat is being lost. These images will allow residents to find their house and see how energy efficient they are. It will also help the council identify the least thermally efficient areas, or house types, within the district and so target home energy efficiency promotions to those areas.

The analysed data shown on the image gives the heat loss from each building on a colour range from dark red (high heat loss) to dark blue (minimal heat loss). It should be stressed, however, that the image only provides a snapshot of heat loss on one particular night. It is worth remembering when looking at your property that there could be other reasons for a property apparently losing no heat, e.g. it could be there was no heating on at the time the image was taken.

It is important to note that there is no 'catchment area admission guarantee' in operation in Staffordshire, and an application for a school place will need to be made at the appropriate time if you wish your child to be admitted. Offers of school places are dependent on spaces being available. However, parents who are refused admission to their preferred school do have a right of appeal through an independent panel. Catchment areas are subject to change and the information provided is correct as at today's date. The data set includes links to detailed information on individual schools held elsewhere on the County Council web pages.

## **Staffordshire Think 2 – Free childcare for 2 year olds (from April 2012)**

**Statement:** This layer shows the eligible areas from April 2012 in which children must live to meet part of the criteria for free childcare. Children may be eligible if they are resident in one of the areas shown on this map layer, if the family is in receipt of certain benefits and their child is born in the eligible period. Please visit the website below to check the full eligibility criteria or if you wish to enquire about a place up to the end of March 2011.

The County Council's offer of free childcare follows the Government's announcement regarding its intention to offer free childcare places (up to 10 hours per week) for 2 year olds who are in the most need. Free childcare has been partially rolled out in the county since April 2010 and was expanded slightly in April 2011.

## Access Land

## Historic Landscape Character (HLC) Layers

**Statement:** These are extracts from the HLC Programme carried out by Staffordshire County Council for the county of Staffordshire, including the area administered by the unitary authority of Stoke-on-Trent City Council. The work was done in partnership with English Heritage as part of a national programme. The overall objective of the HLC project was to characterise, or describe, the county's historic landscape to produce a character map for the entire county. This will aid the understanding and management of the Staffordshire landscape.

The primary objective of the map layers provided are:

1. Historic Landscape Character: To provide a very broad understanding of the 21st century landscape of Staffordshire as identified by the original HLC project.
2. 19th Century HLC: To provide an understanding of the landscape of Staffordshire by the later 19th century as identified by the original HLC project.
3. Medieval HLC: To provide an understanding of the landscape of Staffordshire by the later medieval/early post medieval period as identified by the original HLC project.

**Statement:** SSSIs are the county's very best wildlife and geological sites. They are designated under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended by the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000), and are managed by the land owner but monitored by Natural England. Sites may or may not have public access.

## Public Safety

### **Road Traffic Accidents (Serious) and Road Traffic Accidents (Slight)**

**Statement:** These display 5 and 10 years of road traffic accidents, covering a period up to the last month for which our records are complete (typically around three months prior to the current date). Staffordshire County Council only holds information for accidents on the highway which involve injury to persons, and which have been reported to the Police within 30 days of the incident.

It includes street lighting equipment consisting of street lights, illuminated bollards and illuminated traffic signs. It also includes traffic signal installations for traffic signal controlled junctions, 'Pelican' or 'Puffin' pedestrian crossings, and 'Toucan' crossings shared by pedestrians and cyclists.

## Transport and Streets

### **Local Transport Plan Schemes - Construction Programme**

**Statement:** These are highway schemes in Staffordshire Highways' current construction programme. Schemes "on site" are those currently being constructed. "Completed" schemes are those which have been completed within the last 12 months. Schemes "to be constructed" are those which Staffordshire Highways are planning to construct in the next 12 months.

### **Road and Street Works Information – Works planned or in progress on the public highway**

**Statement:** This displays the notices received for works taking place or proposed to take place on the adopted highway. Works include highway improvements, resurfacing, etc and utility works including water/gas mains replacements, repairs, etc. Notices are required from these organisations as prescribed by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 and secondary legislation. The transfer of these notices between organisations occurs electronically and is therefore reliant on operable systems.

### **Highway Surface Dressing**

**Statement:** Surface dressing is the application of binder and stones to the surface of the road to seal it and prolong its life. This layer displays the locations where highway surface dressing is taking place for the current season (April to August). Prior to work taking place it provides an indicative month based on the programme, and then an actual date that the work was completed. Information for the forthcoming season will be updated in March each year.
