

Dear Parent/Carer

Integrated Review at Age Two

Childcare settings are required to communicate with parents/carers about their child's learning and development. Between 2 and 3 years of age we will complete a summary of your child's development. You will be encouraged to discuss information about how and what your child likes to do at home.

A health visitor / 0-19 practitioner will also complete a health and development review at 2-2½ years. It is useful for the reviews to be shared with your health visitor/0-19 practitioner and ourselves. This is to support the new integrated approach through developing communication links between health, early years and parent/carers to provide a complete, holistic picture of the child's development.

It is important that when you receive the letter from your health visitor/0-19 practitioner/hub inviting you to ring and book an appointment for your child to attend their health and development review, that you inform us as soon as possible. This will enable your child's key person to complete the progress check at age 2 to share during your appointment.

If you require further information, please ask your child's key person or the manager.
