Extra funding to support
your child at their
nursery, preschool
or childminder.






Your child's nursery, preschool or childminder may be able to apply for extra funding to support your child's education.

The money is to help your child:-

- benefit from extra resources and equipment suited to their needs
- experience and enjoy new play and learning activities
- receive support with speech, language and communication
- be better prepared for starting school.

EYPP cannot be used to reduce your fees.





If your child gets up to 15 hours of funded childcare (universal entitlement for three and four year olds) and you claim benefits, ask your childcare provider to apply.

Your childcare provider needs your permission and your National Insurance number, date of birth and full name. This information should be recorded on the parent declaration and privacy notice your childcare provider presents to you.

Your childcare provider submits the EYPP application on your behalf, and they will be told the outcome. You may be asked for evidence that your child is eligible.

Speak to your childcare provider about how the EYPP funding will be used in the best interests of your child.



IS MY CHILD ELIGIBLE?



If your 3 or 4 year old gets up to 15 hours of funded childcare (universal entitlement) and your family claims one of the benefits listed below, ask your childcare provider to apply.

- Universal credit (household income must be less than £7,400 a year after tax, not including any benefits)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided they are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working tax credit run-on, which is paid for 4 weeks after they stop qualifying for working tax credit
