Your programme will be five days a week at the hospital from Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 3.30pm.





If you are interested in joining our Retail Ready Programme at Tesco, you will have the opportunity to work in various retail roles, including 'back of house' and 'customer facing' roles.

You will need to travel to Tesco Extra, Hanley; there is no transport provided.

Your programme will be five days a week, from Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 3.30pm.
You will spend four days per week onsite at Tesco, with a fifth day at Newfriars College.
