Branston – Enabling Works for Topographical Survey

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to make you aware that Amey Highways, on behalf of Staffordshire County Council, will be carrying out enabling works along the embankment located on B5018 Main Street/Burton Road over the Branston Bridge. The work involves clearing a 1m wide strip of ground-level vegetation at 10m intervals along the embankment, from the back of the footway to the toe of the embankment. It is important to note that no trees will be cut or trimmed during this stage. The proposed works will allow the surveyor to undertake a topographical survey that will support the design of widening the footpath.

The investigation work is programmed to start on 26th February 2024 and is expected to last 2 weeks. Please note that the date could change due to exceptional inclement weather or the effects of Covid-19 on staff resource levels.

In order to carry out the work safely and efficiently, lane closure with temporary traffic lights will be used to manage local and through traffic. Pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained throughout; however, we do ask that you take extra care when passing through this section of works.
