Scheme Update – July 2021

Introduction

We continue to make great progress with works to the viaduct continuing between Madford Retail Park and Doxey Road Car parks with the first layer surfacing planned for August. Doxey Road railway bridge is fully open, works are ongoing to the footways running along the railway line on Doxey Road as you approach the bridge, with surfacing planned for August.

Landscaping and maintenance works are ongoing in readiness for scheme completion. Accommodation works will commence at Madford RP and Doxey Road car parks which will include drainage, kerbing, surfacing, white lining and flood lighting.



The Kingsway and Martin Drive closure is planned to carry out resurfacing works to the existing carriageway near the new toucan crossings. The closure will take place week commencing 2nd August and be in place for 5 days subject to any unforeseen circumstances.
