Scheme Update – March 2020

Introduction

Since our last update the scheme has been moving forward with the piling works, the demolition works and the widening and realignment of the carriageway on Doxey Road in the Timberfields area.

Stafford Western Access Route will provide additional highway capacity to the west of Stafford and will enable the removal of through traffic from the town centre, creating improved conditions for bus services, pedestrians and cyclists. It is also essential to the delivery of housing, new business and leisure development.

We are constantly reviewing the guidance from the Government and our Senior Management teams on a daily basis in relation to us continuing to deliver the scheme, should we have any further updates we will keep you updated along the way.
