STAFFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL DECISION NOTICE

COMMONS ACT 2006 SCHEDULE 2 PARAGRAPH 6 TO DEREGISTER A BUILDING WRONGLY REGISTERED AS COMMON LAND CL25 - LAND AT DRAWELL LANE WERRINGTON

An application has been made to Staffordshire County Council, as Registration Authority, by Mr and Mrs Ireland under Section 22 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application sought to deregister land that is covered by a building or is within the curtilage of a building that has been wrongly registered as common land under CL25.

No representations or objections have been made to the application and the Registration Authority is satisfied that the application complies with the requirements of Schedule 2 Paragraph 6 of the Commons Act 2006 and Schedule 4, Paragraph 14 to the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The Registration Authority has considered all the evidence with regard to this proposal and concludes that on the balance of probabilities the proposal meets the criteria set out in the legislation.

The Registration Authority has therefore decided to grant the application and correct the entry in the commons register under CL25 to exclude the area set out in the application.
