

**The Commons Act 2006
Section 22: Schedule 2 (6)
To deregister a building or a curtilage of a building
wrongly registered as common land**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Christopher Forrester and Rebecca Anne Forrester to Staffordshire County Council as Commons Registration Authority, concerning land at The Haven, Bank End, Brown Edge, Stoke on Trent ST6 8QR described more fully below.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: the land was provisionally registered as common land under the 1965 Act on the date of provisional registration 14 June 1967, the land was covered by a building or was within the curtilage of a building; the provisional registration became final 01 October 1970 and since the date of provisional registration the land has at all times been, and still is, covered by a building or within the curtilage of a building.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by removing the land or said part of land from the register of common land.
