

## STAFFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL DECISION NOTICE

COMMONS ACT 2006 SCHEDULE 2, PARAGRAPH 8
APPLICATION TO DE-REGISTER A BUILDING
WRONGLY REGISTERED AS A TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN
VG32 – LAND AT "CASWELL", KINGSLEY BANK, FROGHALL

An application has been made to Staffordshire County Council, as Registration Authority, by D. J. Hurst under Section 22 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 to deregister a building wrongly registered as a town or village green under reference VG32.

No representations or objections have been made to the application and the Registration Authority is satisfied that the application complies with the requirements of the Commons Act 2006 Schedule 2, Paragraph 8 and Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 Schedule 4, Paragraph 14.

The Registration Authority has considered all the evidence with regard to this proposal and concludes that on the balance of probabilities the proposal meets the criteria set out in the legislation. Therefore, it has decided to grant the application and correct the entry in the commons register under VG32 in reference to land adjacent to property called "Caswell", located on Kingsley Bank, Froghall.
