Notification of carriageway reconstruction works on the A5127 Trent Valley Road, Lichfield

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads in Staffordshire, Amey Services Ltd working with Staffordshire County Council, will shortly begin carrying out works on the A5127 Trent Valley Road, from St Michaels Court to 51 Trent Valley Road and at either side of the junctions of Wissage Road. Works will include the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface, along with other preparation works known as civil works. This location was highlighted by the local County Councilors for Lichfield, and forms part of the wider highway investment works to help increase the lifespan of the roads in Staffordshire.

From **Monday 25 March 2024**, we'll begin the first phase of the scheme. This will include the installation of a new tactile crossing, replacing and adjustments of kerbs where necessary and minor footway patching.

These initial works will be carried out under an off -peak road closure, between the hours of **9.30am – 3pm** where either side of the junction of Wissage Road will be closed. A local signed diversion route will be in place for residents and businesses during this time. Outside of these times, Wissage Road will remain open during this phase of works. Temporary traffic signals will be in operation 24/7 on Trent Valley Road. The civil works are due to be completed on **Thursday 28 March 2024**.

Following on from the civil works, we will begin our carriageway reconstruction works, this will include the re-setting and replacement of carriageway ironworks, the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface, along with the replacement of new traffic loops and road markings. Works will take place from **Tuesday 2 to Friday 5 April** and **Monday 8 to Friday 12 April 2024** between the hours of **19.30pm to 6am**.

To allow this work to be carried out safely, and to minimise disruption, we'll be working overnight when traffic volumes are lower.

Please see the table on page 3, which provides details about the road closures, working times for both daytime and overnight work, along with details about the phases of work.

Due to the size and scale of construction machines being used and to ensure the safety of the general public and workforce, sections of the carriageway will at times become impassable and therefore, it will be necessary to close Trent Valley Road and at either side of the junctions of Wissage Road to through traffic during our overnight works. During our overnight works, there will be parking restrictions in place within the areas of works on Trent Valley Road.

A primary road diversion route will be in place for through traffic during the closures.

Local signed diversion routes will be in place during the closures; along with designated personnel at either end of the closure points to offer assistance and assist with access when safe to do so to residential properties and businesses. Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journeys.

Pedestrian access along the length of the works will be maintained throughout.

Additional signage will be placed at key strategic points, directing members of the public wanting to access Samuel Johnson Community Hospital during the overnight closures.

Bus stops along Trent Valley Road will be suspended during the overnight closures. If you require any further information about this service, please speak to your bus operator.

Unfortunately, with any major highway works, some disturbance is unavoidable, and there may be short delays even on the approaches to the closure points. I must ask that you drive carefully and slowly through any sections of live roadworks for both the workforces and your own safety.

During the road closure period, waste and recycling collections will remain the same, on their normal collection delays.

Please note that all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements and weather conditions.

The works may at times be noisy, and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disturbance caused. We'll do our best to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible. We like to thank you for your patience during this works.
