Update – Nighttime carriageway resurfacing of A34 between Queensville and Riverway, Stafford

Staffordshire County Council together with Amey will be carrying out the above works with full road closures during weeknights from 8pm to 6am, commencing on 28th August until approximately 10th October. Between 9th and 19th September, the nighttime closures will be removed for site testing.

Road closures will start 8pm on Mondays and end 6am on Saturdays, with no access for through traffic.

Preparation works for surfacing

- Thursday 28th & Friday 29th August

Initial surfacing

- Monday 1st - Friday 5th September
- Monday 8th September

Testing – No nighttime road closures are planned between

- *Tuesday 9th September and Friday 19th September*

Final surfacing

- Monday 22nd - Friday 26th September
- Monday 29th September

Road markings

- Thursday 25th & Friday 26th September
- Monday 29th September – Friday 4th October
- Monday 6th – Friday 10th October

Final surfacing works to Queensville Bridge is currently planned for late October and exact details will be sent to directly affected frontagers once dates have been confirmed.

Please note that all dates and times are subject to changes should any delays occur due to poor weather or breakdowns.

Due to the nature of the works, unfortunately vehicle access to frontages will be restricted for the majority of the nighttime closures from 28th August. The works will be carried out in phases and further information will be provided to directly affected frontagers as the work progress. Access arrangements for

- properties between 1 & 36 Queensville will be from Queensville Roundabout (east of Queensville Bridge)
- properties between 24 and 106 Lichfield Road will be from Riverway (west of Queensville Bridge)

Any changes will be communicated via advanced works signs, displayed on site and also posted on the Staffordshire County Council website.

If this presents a problem or if you have any specific access requirements, please speak to the staff on site.

Please conform to the traffic management, drive with caution and treat our workforce with respect at all times.

Diversion routes will be signed for all through traffic.

Although we will do our best to keep this to minimum, please be aware that the works will generate noise throughout each working shift.

Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience which may be caused, and we thank you for your continued patience throughout the duration of these essential works.
