Scheme update of carriageway reconstruction works on the B5493 Aldergate and A513 Upper Gungate

We write to update you with progress so far and provide an update of phase time scales and planned works as phase four commences with night-time closures.

Due to the nature and scale of the machinery used in a complex operations, sections of carriageway will at times become impassable. In order for activities to take place safely for our team members and colleagues, it will be necessary to temporarily close the route to through traffic. Each phase of work has been selected for daytime or night-time working hours due to impact on traffic and with consideration to businesses and residents including where noise is expected during the night.

A signed diversion route will be in place along with designated personnel at either end of the closure points to offer advice and assist with access to properties within the closure points.

Please plan ahead allowing extra time for your journeys.

I have outlined on the reverse of this letter, the times when sections of road closures will be in place. Further details are available for businesses on request via reportit as below.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may create, however these measures are essential for us to make such improvements, and we kindly ask for your patience during this time.
