What Bags are available?

Each Bag is themed to support one of the seven strands of Early Years' learning

- Speech Language and Communication
- Physical Development
- Understanding of the World
- Creativity and Imagination
- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Literacy
- Numeracy

The Bags are age-appropriate and available for Babies (Birth to 15 months), Toddlers (15 months to 3 years) and Young Children (3+ years)

What's in the Bags?

Each Bag contains a simple age-appropriate learning activity with instructions, suggestions for further activity ideas and useful information about how your child develops; a book for you to share with your child; a Local Partner Pack containing leaflets and information about services for families in your area; suggestions for websites offering parenting information and support and an optional Kobo e-reader so that you can download e-books from Staffordshire Libraries for free to share with your child at home.



I would like to borrow a Bag. What do I need to do?

Please fill out the form on the back of this leaflet and hand it in to your local library. To order a Bag you will need your library card number; if you are not a library member you can join FREE at any Staffordshire Library.

I have ordered a Bag, what happens next?

Your order will be passed to the library where the Bags are stored. If your Bag is available we will send it to your chosen library within 10 working days of receiving your order. Your library will then contact you to let you know that the Bag has arrived and can be collected. The Bag can be borrowed for 3 weeks.



If the Bag you have asked for is not available, we will contact you with an estimate of when it is likely to become available.

I work in Early Years. Can I borrow the Bags?
