

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984
THE STAFFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(INNOVATION DRIVE, PENDEFORD)
(BUSES, PEDAL CYCLES AND MOTOR CYCLES ONLY) ORDER 2014

The Staffordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"local bus" means a public service vehicle used for the provision of a local service not being an excursion or tour;

"local service" has the meaning given in Section 2 of the Transport Act 1985;

"motor cycle" has the meaning given in Section 136 of the Act;

"pedal cycle" has the meaning given in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"public service vehicle" has the meaning given in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a local bus, pedal cycle or motor cycle to enter, proceed or be in the following length of road:

Innovation Drive, Pendeford – from a point approximately 100 metres north of its roundabout junction with Wobaston Road/ The Drove way in a northerly direction to its roundabout junction with Valiant Way.

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or be in the length of road specified in this Order if the vehicle is being used:

(a) For the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road;

(b) for the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or in land adjacent to the said road of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Communications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Communications Act 1984;

(c) in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker or the Environment Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(d) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

(e) in the service of a universal service provider to deliver or collect postal packets as defined in Section 125(1) of the Postal Services Act 2000 to premises adjacent to the bus lane.

4. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or be in the length of road specified in this Order if the vehicle is being used under the direction of a police constable in uniform or for the purposes of crossing a bus lane.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the 11 December 2014 and may be cited as the Staffordshire County Council (Innovation Drive, Pendeford) (Buses, Pedal Cycles and Motor Cycles Only) Order 2014.
