About Your Information

We keep some information about you to help give you the care and support you need. This includes your name, address, health, and who helps take care of you.

Why we keep your information

We use your information to plan your care, make services better, and tell the government how we are helping people.

How long we keep your information

We keep your information for a few years after we help you. Then we delete it safely.

Who do you share your information with

We sometimes share your information with doctors, police, or other partners if it helps keep you safe or is needed for your care arrangements.

Your Rights
