**(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO 13(A) (PART) ALTON PARISH)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**


This Order is made by Staffordshire County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that, in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this Order, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mrs. S. Brown, the said owner, has agreed to defray any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Staffordshire Moorlands District Council has been consulted as to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The bridleway over the land situate at Alton Parish and shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up on the date that the Authority certifies that works have been carried out to bring the site of the new bridleway described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority an alternative bridleway for use as a replacement for the said bridleway as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map contained in this order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the Limitations and Conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
4. The cost of the bridlegates described in Part 3 of the Schedule has been covered by the British Horse Society and Staffordshire Moorlands Bridleways Group.
5. Where immediately before the date on which the bridleway is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on along or across it, belonging to statutory undertakers for the purposes of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That length of Public Bridleway No 13(a) Alton Parish running from point A on the Order plan (406514 342457) in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 280 metres to point B on the Order plan (406660 342230).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A new length of Public Bridleway No 13(a) Alton Parish running from point A on the Order plan (406514 342457) in a generally south south-easterly direction for approximately 120 metres to point C on the Order plan (406540 342335) then turning to head in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 164 metres to point B on the Order plan (406660 342230).

The new route shall have a prescribed width of 3 metres between points A-C-B.

PART 3

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

Two bridlegates in accordance with BS5709:2006 have been installed at point A (406514 342457) and point B (406660 342230) on the Order plan.


