CX078 - Notification of carriageway reconstruction works on the U4012 Bretby Lane, Burton Upon Trent

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads in Staffordshire, Amey Services Ltd working with Staffordshire County Council will shortly begin carrying out works on the U4012 Bretby Lane. Works will take place on Bretby Lane from the junction of Ashby Road to the Bretby Lane roundabout (including Bretby Lane to the South Derbyshire boundary). Works to include the junction of Moat Bank Lane, Melbourne Road and Empire Road

The programme of works will include the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface, along with new road markings, (and associated preparatory works known as 'civil works'), which will include site investigation works, ground radar surveys, drainage repairs and clearance, kerbing replacement, ironwork repairs and minor footway improvements. The replacement of damaged signs and edging off the footways, where the grass has reduced the full width.

From **07.30am on Monday 12 October 2026**, we'll begin the first phase of the scheme, starting with the civil works. Works will take place, **Monday to Friday** between the hours of **7.30am to 5pm**. These initial works will be carried out under temporary traffic signals during the daytime. Temporary traffic signals may need to remain in place overnight to guard open excavations and to allow for material curing times. The civil works are due to be completed on **Monday 16 November 2026**.

From **Tuesday 17 November 2026 to Tuesday 8 December 2026**, we will begin our second phase of the scheme, which is the carriageway resurfacing works, (**Monday to Friday**) between the hours of **7.30am to 5pm** where **daytime road closures will be in place**.

All works are due to be completed by **Tuesday 8 December 2026**.

Works will include, utility survey works, ahead of removing the existing carriageway surface and re-setting the carriageway ironworks. The new carriageway surface will then be laid, ahead of emptying the highway gullies and finally replacing the new road markings.

During the carriageway resurfacing works, there will be no on street parking on the highway, **Monday to Friday**. This restriction is necessary to ensure the safety of both the public and the workforce. Access to driveway frontages will be maintained, however there may be short delays whilst materials are being removed and cured.

Due to the size and scale of construction machines being used and to ensure the safety of the general public and workforce, the scheme of works will be carried out under **daytime full road closures** between the hours of **7.30am to 5pm (Monday to Friday)**. **Outside of these times, the roads will remain open.**

Diversion route

A signed diversion route will be in place during the closures; along with designated personnel at either end of the closure points to offer assistance with residential properties and business access. Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journeys.

Please speak to the site team, so that we can help with any specific needs or requirements you may have during this works.

We've included a map of the diversion route at the end of this letter, and it can also be viewed on our scheme webpage. See webpage details below.

Emergency services will be given access through the road closures when safe to do so.

Pedestrian access along the length of the works will be maintained throughout.

Regrettably, bus stops along the scheme of works will be suspended during the road closures. If you require any further information about this service, please speak to your bus operator.

Unfortunately, with any major highway works, some disturbance is unavoidable, and there may be short delays even on the approaches to the closure points. We must ask that you drive carefully and slowly through any sections of live roadworks for both the workforces and your own safety.

Please note that all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements and weather conditions.

The works may at times be noisy, and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disturbance caused. We'll do our best to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible. We like to thank you for your patience during this works.
